



Get paid while you learn another foreign language. Become a linguist for the United States Army and receive the following:

- Enlistment bonus of up to \$20,000. .
- Montgomery G.I. Bill and Army College Fund- up to \$50,000 for college.
- Loan Repayment Program - up to \$65,000 to help pay student loans.
- Language training worth 45 college credits at the world class Defense Language Institute in Monterey, Calif.
- Earn your degree while in training.

Soldiers completing a course of study at Defense Language Institute (DLI) are awarded up to 45 college credits. These credits can be used to complete an Associate in Arts Degree at Monterey Peninsula College. Soldiers who have completed some college prior to joining the Army can work toward a Baccalaureate or Master's degree while at DLI at a variety of local colleges. Many soldiers find they are able to complete their degree requirements while stationed at DLI.

- Tuition Assistance - continue your education while on Active Duty and
- The Army pays 75% of your tuition.
- Foreign Language Proficiency Pay of up to \$300 per month.
- Receive **top-secret** security clearance - this can help you obtain a high paying civilian or government job after completing your term of service.
