



**The United States Army has the following opportunities available:
Warrant Officer Flight Training (WOFT)**

Qualifications:

- Available to qualified applicants with or without prior military service enlisting for three years.
- Applicant must be a high school diploma graduate.
- Must be at least 19 years of age and not passed 29th birthday at time of Regular Army enlistment.
- Must be a U.S. citizen – green card.
- Preferred applicants should have at least should have at least 2 years of college.
- Applicant must score 90 or higher on the revised Flight Aptitude Selection Test (FAST).
- Must achieve a minimum general technical score of 110 on the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB Test).
- Applicant must undergo a comprehensive Class 1 Flight Physical.
- Applicants must meet Army weight and height standards. Candidates will be no taller than 6’4” and no shorter than 5’4” in height.

Salary:

- Candidates will receive \$1,332.60 monthly while in Warrant Officer Candidate School (WOCS).
- Candidates may be eligible to receive up to \$19,296 through the Montgomery GI Bill tuition assistance program.
