

FAMILY MEMBER BENEFITS

TRICARE PRIME REMOTE:

TRICARE DENTAL (UNITED CONCORDIA):

The Tricare Dental Program (TDP) provides a high quality, cost-effective dental care benefit for **family members** of all active duty Uniformed Service personnel. To be eligible for the TDP, the sponsor must have at least 12 months remaining on his/her service commitment.

Individuals eligible to enroll in the TDP include the following:

1. Family members of active duty, Selected Reserve, and IRR service members. This includes spouses and unmarried children (including stepchildren, adopted children, and wards) under the age of 21. Family members will be eligible up to the end of the month in which they turn 21. Family members may be eligible after age 21 if:
 - they are enrolled full time at an accredited college or university and they are more than 50 percent dependent on the sponsor for financial support. These students are eligible to the end of the month in which they turn age 23. If the student terminates his/her education prior to turning 23, eligibility ends at the end of the month in which education terminates.
 - they have a disabling illness or injury that occurred before their 21st birthday, or between the ages of 21 and 23 if they were enrolled as a full time student at the time of the illness or injury, and they were more than 50 percent dependent on the sponsor for financial support.

Because Tricare Dental (United Concordia) verifies member eligibility from the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS), it is extremely important that sponsors ensure that DEERS contains up-to-date information on each family member.
