New \$6,000 bonus for Reserve Officer, Warrant Officer recruits

FORT KNOX, Ky. – The U.S. Army Recruiting Command today announced a new \$6,000 bonus for qualified individuals who enlist in the Army Reserve for the Officer Candidate School or Warrant Officer Candidate Flight Training program.

Officer candidates, who apply for eligible Areas of Concentration (AOC) such as aviation, ordnance, transportation, petroleum supply, engineer and health services, may now qualify for a \$6,000 bonus. Eligibility is based on the applicant's civilian education or technical skills, length of enlistment, previous military service, and assignment to an Army Reserve troop program unit (TPU) in the selected AOC for six years. Bonus payments are contingent upon satisfactorily completing all phases of training. Bonus amounts, eligibility criteria and qualifying AOCs are subject to change.

Army Reserve Soldiers combine civilian skills with military training to provide specialized support for military missions around the world.
