Army Recruiting Command announces prior service enlistment bonuses

FORT KNOX, Ky. – The U.S. Army Recruiting Command today announced increased enlistment bonuses for those individuals with prior military service who enlist in the Army Reserve and have been previously trained in certain military occupational specialties.

The enlistment bonuses for those prior service enlistees have been increased to the highest levels in Army Reserve history -- up to \$8,000 for a six-year enlistment or up to \$4,000 for a three-year enlistment.

Enlistment bonuses for those prior service enlistees who choose to train for a new military occupational specialty in the Army Reserve are also available. They can now receive a \$5,000 bonus for a six-year enlistment or up to \$2,500 for a three-year enlistment.

To be eligible for these bonuses, individuals who previously served in the Army must have completed their eight-year military service obligation.
