Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Justin W. Blewitt is a 92R parachute rigger serving as a member of the United States Army Parachute Team on the Formation Free Fall Competition Team.

SFC Blewitt joined the Army in May of 2004, attended his initial entry training and was then assigned to Fort Benning, Ga. In the fall of 2005 he chose to attend the Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program, which the knights use as a tool to assess a jumpers skydiving trainability as well as their teamwork skills.



Since learning to skydive in 2001 he has done more than 4,500 free fall parachute jumps and 25 military static line jumps.

His most recent accomplishments include winning one Gold and two Silver medals at the 2010 U.S. National Skydiving Championships. He and his Team also brought back Silver from the World Meet in Menzelinsk, Russia. In 2011 he won four Gold Medals at the U.S. Nationals and 1 Gold at the World Cup at Saarlouis Germany.

During his free time he enjoys rock climbing, and snowboarding.
