Biographical Sketch

Mr. Darrin Grim is the demonstration show coordinator. Grim enlisted into the Army in 1985 and after twenty years of military service he retired from the Army but remained on the team.

Grim attended the 1991 Assessment and Selection Program and upon being 'knighted' he served three years as a demonstration parachutist on the Black Demonstration Team. He left the team to fulfill other military obligations, only to return to the Knights in 1998 as the assistant team leader for the Black and then Gold Demonstration Teams. In 2001 Grim became a show coordinator in Operations and has been there ever since.

While he was in the Army he served in Operation Desert Storm and Desert Shield earned the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Kuwaiti Liberation Medal and many more.

Since learning to skydive in 1983 he has logged more than 2,500 freefall parachute jumps, 100 tandem jumps and 42 military static line jumps.

During his free time he enjoys golf, guitar, snowboarding and spending time with his family participating in motocross events.
