Throughout his career, duty stations have included Florida National Guard as an Infantryman and Team Leader. From there he deployed to Afghanistan for a 1 year tour, then later he went to the

New Jersey National Guard at Ft Dix where he worked in the G-3 shop and was tasked to help set up the New Jersey Army National Guard Parachute Team. He has been awarded the ARCOM, Army Commendation Medal, and the AAM, Army Achievement Medal.



In 2010 he applied for the rigorous Assessment and Selection Program of the USAPT. Upon completion of the program he was then made a member of the Team.

Since learning to skydive in 2005 he has logged more than 624 free fall parachute jumps. David is also an experienced wind tunnel instructor with over 2,000 hours of tunnel time. He also has five military static line jumps.
