Prior to making the United States Army Parachute Team; Staff Sergeant has served as a Senior Mechanic at Ft Bragg, NC, a Senior Mechanic at Vincenza, Italy from where he deployed to Iraq. In Eureka, CA he worked as a Recruiter and finally returned back to Ft Bragg as the Company Motor Sergeant from where he deployed again to Iraq and to Afghanistan.

He has made 48 Airborne Static line and over 250 free fall parachute jumps.
