He has been awarded the Bronze Star, the Army Commendation, the Army Achievement Medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal, North Atlantic Treaty Organization Medal. Hill has also earned the Master Parachutist Badge, Expert Infantry, Combat Action, Pathfinder and Drill Sergeant Badge.

Since learning to skydive in 2005 he has logged more than 1,500 free fall parachute jumps, and 120 military static line jumps.
