## Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Joshua E. Coleman is a 92R, Parachute Maintenance Technician, who spent several seasons as a Demonstration Parachutist is now assigned to the Free Fall Formation Competition Team.

Coleman enlisted into the Army in September 2001 and has completed one tour with the 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC with whom he deployed to Iraq for eight and a half months in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.



In the fall of 2004 Coleman chose to attend the rigorous Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program held every year. Upon completion of this six-week program Coleman was assigned to Black Demonstration Team.

His most recent accomplishments include winning one Gold and two Silver medals at the 2010 U.S. National Skydiving Championships. He and his Team also brought back Silver from the World Meet in Menzelinsk, Russia. In 2011 he and team won 4 gold medals at the U.S. Nationals and 1 Gold at the World Cup in Saarlouis, Germany.

Since Coleman started jumping in July 2001 he has completed more than 4,500 freefall parachute jumps.

When Coleman isn't working he enjoys surfing, rock climbing, hunting, fishing, and skydiving.
