Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Brian Krause is a 52X, Maintenance Supervisor serving as the Competition Team Leader for the Golden Knights.

Krause entered the Army in January 1993 and after a tour of duty in the 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC, he volunteered for the Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program in 1998.

After being 'Knighthooded' in 1998 he competed with the Style & Accuracy Team for two-years. After which he chose to compete as a member of the Formation Free fall Team, winning more than 70 medals in nine years. Some of his accomplishments include winning a Gold Medal and setting a world record at the 32nd Military World Championships in Ryazan, Russia. They won a Gold, two Silver and one Bronze medal at the 2010 U.S. National Skydiving Championships. He and his Team also brought back Silver from the World Meet in Menzelinsk, Russia. Currently his Team is the World Cup Champions of 8 way formation Skydiving. Most recently they won four Gold and One Silver medal at the U.S. National Skydiving Championships at Eloy, AZ.



Since learning to sky dive in 1995 he has logged more than 15,000 free fall parachute jumps, 50 tandems and 66 military static line jumps.
