Throughout his career duty stations have included Vilseck, Germany where he served as a Scout Gunner. Later he went to Camp Casey, Korea as a Squad Leader. From there he worked as a Senior Scout at Ft Carson, CO. Later he attended Drill Sergeant school and became an instructor right back where it all started for him at Ft Knox, KY. It was 2010 when he applied to the USAPT for acceptance to the rigorous Assessment and Selection Program. Upon completion Dustin was selected to become a Demonstration Parachutist with the Gold Demonstration Team.



SFC Peregrin has served two tours in Iraq with the Second Infantry Division. He has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal, BSM, Meritorious service medal, three Army Commendations, ARCOMs, and the Iraqi Campaign Medal with two Campaign Stars, ICM 2CS, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, GWOTSM and the Korea Defense Service Medal, KDSM. He has also earned the Combat Action Badge and Drill Sergeant Badge.
