Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Sean M. Sweeney is an 11B, Airborne Infantryman, serving on the Golden Knights as a competitor on the Formation Freefall Team.

Sweeney enlisted into the Army in January 2003. Upon completion of his initial entry training he was assigned to the 1st Battalion 325th Parachute Infantry Regiment 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, N.C.



In November 2003 Sweeney completed the Assessment and Selection Program for the Golden Knights and upon being 'knighted' he went to work supporting the Gold Demonstration Team. In 2006 he started working for the Competition Team. Since then he has won more than 20 medals for the Army. His most recent accomplishments include winning four Gold, and one Silver medal at the 2011 U.S. National Skydiving Championships. He and his Team also brought back Gold from the World Cup in Saarlouis, Germany.

Since he first began skydiving in 2002 Sweeney has made more than 5,000 freefall parachute jumps.

In his free time Sweeney enjoys spending time with his family.
