Biographical Sketch

Sergeant 1st Class Greg A. Windmiller is an Airborne Ranger serving as a competitor on the Canopy Piloting Team.

Windmiller enlisted into the Army in July 1990 and upon completion of his initial entry training he was assigned to the Long Range Surveillance Detachment 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Hovey Korea, LRSD of the 82nd Airborne Division on Fort Bragg, and finally the 4th Ranger Training Battalion at Fort Benning used Windmiller to teach its own soldiers.

In the fall of 2000, Windmiller attended the rigorous Assessment and Selection Program for the Knights. Upon being 'knighted' he was assigned to the Style and Accuracy Team, then later he took a slot on the Tandem Team as a videographer / tandem Instructor. He has now returned to competition as a Canopy Piloting Competitor. Since his first jump in 1990 Windmiller has logged more than 11,000 free fall parachute jumps, 150 static line jumps and 2,000 tandems.



In 2008 Windmiller placed 3rd in the World Championships of Canopy Piloting in South Africa and also set a new World Record in the Speed Event. In 2009 he broke that same speed record again and took a World Silver Medal. In the U.S., Greg is The current two time National Champion for the Speed category and holds all US National Canopy Piloting Records. Most recently, in 2011, he won 2 International Gold Medals at the Dubai Cup.

When he's not jumping, Windmiller enjoys fishing and hunting.
