1. This MILPER message will expire NLT 30 September 2017.

2. MILPER message 16-231, is amended as follows:

a. Paragraph 6 is amended to add the Accessions Occupational Physical Assessment Test (OPAT) Implementation.

Effective 3 January 2017, personnel applying for a WO MOS that is grouped in a higher Physical Demand Category (PDC) compared to their current MOS/AOC must take an OPAT prior to application submission. Example: 68W (Moderate-PDC) applying for 153A (Heavy-PDC).

b. Paragraph 7b is amended to add OPAT administration requirements to local Commanders IAW reference K.

Effective 3 January 2017, the Soldier's local commander is responsible for ensuring the OPAT is administered prior to approval of the Soldier's warrant officer selection board application when applicable, using local installation assets.
