MEMORANDUM FOR

SUBJECT: Instructions for individual units requesting database and reports.

Attached are step by step instructions for Soldiers to create a Sergeant Major of the Army Recruiting Team (SMART) account. These instructions must be followed to ensure that qualified Soldiers will be eligible for the referral bonus and that your units will receive accurate reports of referral data.

When Soldiers open their SMART account for the first time, they will see their AKO data already in the system. They must provide complete information for all the required tabs, including the unit UIC box. While the Web site shows this box as optional, for tracking and reporting purposes it is a required field that **MUST** be completed.

It is imperative that all Soldiers are aware of this requirement and input their unit UIC in order to track to the lowest level. Soldiers who already possess an account on the SMART website can update their profiles at any time, to add a missing UIC or update change of station information.

Since the SMART site is reliant on human input, failure to submit the UIC will ultimately allow release of inaccurate information.

Battalion and higher-level Commanders wishing to request a unit compliance update can make a request via e-mail to george.silva@usarec.army.mil. The request **MUST** include all UICs of the requested/subordinate units. Because of the large number of reports currently generated, we cannot pull generate reports for below the Battalion level, except in the case of separate units.

Only those registered Soldiers who have made referrals will appear on the incentives report. Soldiers who are registered only, but have not made any referrals, will not be included.

We will continue to provide as much support as resources allow. 24 hour turn around for unit reports is available, based on correct input of the UIC. Units are requested to limit their report requests to immediate needs only. Resources at this time do not allow for regularly scheduled reporting.

Sergeant Major of the Army Recruiting Team (SMART)

☆ **What is SMART ?**

- ← An integral team that assists USAREC in meeting the Army's recruiting mission
 - ✿ Initiated in 1998
 - ✿ Encourages all Soldiers to assist the United States Army Recruiting Command with recruiting efforts

☆ **What the program does**

- ← Creates a partnership and promotes camaraderie between the recruiting battalions and the installation/regional support commands in their battalion area.
- ← Encourages Soldiers to provide referrals interested in the Army and Army Reserve

☆ **Eligible Sponsors**

- ← Everyone who makes a referral through the SMART referral program is eligible for the Sergeant Major of the Army Certificate, provided the referral enlists into the Army or Army Reserve (Retired Military, Veteran's Organization, Civilians etc.)

☆ **Where do I make a referral? What kind of referrals can be made?**

- ← Referrals are made through the ARS-SMART website at: <http://www.2k.army.mil>
- ← Referrals may be non-prior service or prior service

☆ **Are there incentives for making a referral?**

- ← You may be eligible for a certificate signed by the Sergeant Major of the Army for any referral who enlists into the Regular Army or the Army Reserve

Referral Bonus Pilot Program

☆ What is the Referral Bonus Pilot Program?

- ← The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) 2006 gave the SecArmy temporary authority (under Sec. 645 of the NDAA) to pay a bonus to a member of the Army, whether in the Active Army, Army National Guard or Army Reserve, who refer non-prior service individuals to an Army, Army Reserve or Army National Guard recruiter

☆ When did this program become effective?

- ← The program became effective 18 January 2006

☆ What the program does

- ← Pays qualified sponsors a Referral Bonus of \$1000.00 once the Soldier (referral) has completed and graduated from One Station Unit Training (OSUT) or Initial Entry Training (IET). Processing of the Referral Bonus is initiated once graduation is confirmed by HQ USAREC. Note: 18 Jan 06 through 12 Nov 2006
- ← On 13 Nov 06 the Referral Bonus increase the bonus to \$2,000.00 payable in two increments. \$1,000.00 will be paid to the eligible sponsor once the Soldier (referral) has commenced Basic Training. \$1,000.00 will be paid to the eligible sponsor once the Soldier (referral) has completed and graduated from One Station Unit Training (OSUT) or Initial Entry Training (IET). Processing of the Referral Bonus is initiated once graduation is confirmed by HQ USAREC
 - ⊗ Soldiers may contact HQ USAREC or the Army National Guard POC's to submit a pay inquiry
 - ⊗ Pay inquiries will not be handled by local DMPO

Sponsor Eligibility

✧ Eligible Sponsors

- ← Active Army
- ← Army Reserve
- ← Army National Guard
- ← Soldiers who participate in the Hometown Recruiter Assistance Program (HRAP), Special Recruiter Assistance Program (SRAP) (If you are on HRAP or SRAP the referral must also be entered into the HRAP database) and Active Duty for Special Work (ADSW)
- ← Army ROTC Contracted Cadets
- ← United States Military Academy Cadets
- ← Future Soldiers
- ← Army Retirees (Active, Reserve, or National Guard) to include Army Reserve component retirees, which includes Reserve members receiving retired pay, Reserve members who have transferred to the Retired Reserve after completing the requisite qualifying years creditable for retired pay, but who have not yet reached 60 years of age.
- ← Department of the Army Civilians (DAC)

✧ Ineligible Sponsors

- ← Recruiting or Retention duties or assigned to duties regarding which eligibility for a bonus could be perceived as creating a conflict of interest
- ← Detailed or Cadre Recruiters, Contract Recruiters, General Schedule (GS) Recruiters, Company Commander's, 1SG's, Battalion and Brigade Commanders and CSM's
- ← Retention Career Counselors or personnel serving in equivalent positions in the Army National Guard
- ← Civilians, contractors or military that are working as SROTC/JROTC Instructors, Military Science Instructors and Recruiting Operation Officers

Referral Eligibility

☆ Referrals must be

- ← Non-prior service that are interested in joining the enlisted ranks.
 - ← To include applicants that enlist for:
 - ← Officer Candidate School (OCS)
 - ← Warrant Officer Flight Training (WOFT)

☆ Referrals may not be

- ← Currently in any stage of processing (Appointment conducted by recruiter) for enlistment, prior service, an immediate family member (spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, adopted child, brother, sister step brother or step sister)

Incentives

☆ **Types of Recognition and Awards**

- ← Referral Bonus of \$2,000 dollars for a referral that enlists into the Army, Army Reserve or Guard
- ← 2-Star note from CG-USAREC
- ← Certificate from the Sergeant Major of the Army
- ← Anyone serving on an additional duty (HRAP, SRAP or ADSW) may receive
 - ← Letter of Appreciation from Battalion Commander or Command Sergeant Major
 - ← Recommendation for impact awards must be made through the Soldiers parent unit

Army Referral System - Sergeant Major of the Army Recruiting Team (ARS-SMART)

The Army Referral System - Sergeant Major of the Army Recruiting Team (ARS-SMART) provides a way for people to provide referrals who are interested in enlisting into the U.S. Army and/or Army Reserve. The program allows anyone to assist the Army's recruiting force in providing the strength for America's Army. Everyone who makes a referral through the SMART referral program is eligible for the Sergeant Major of the Army Certificate, provided the referral enlists into the Army or Army Reserve.

\$2K Referral Bonus Pilot Program (\$2K)

ARS-SMART is also the gateway for those eligible sponsors who are making referrals for the \$2,000 Referral Bonus Program. Soldiers, USMA Cadets, ROTC Contracted Cadets, Future Soldiers, Army component retirees and Department of the Army Civilians may receive a Referral Bonus for referring anyone, except immediate family members. Special Recruiter Assistant Program (SRAP)

The Special Recruiter Assistance Program (SRAP) allows Soldiers who have served in Operations Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom to share their deployment experiences and return to their hometowns on a short-term TDY for up to 14 days to assist the local recruiters by sharing their first-hand experiences with friends, student leaders, and community leaders.

All active duty Soldiers and Army Reserve OIF/OEF veterans may request to participate in the SRAP program.

SRAP Soldiers may be eligible for the \$2,000 Referral Bonus if those referrals result in an enlistment.

General Officer Speaking Opportunities

Army leaders interested in supporting Army Recruiting by speaking in their hometowns, at their alma maters or in other locations in which they have ties are requested to complete a short online survey with their contact information. Information will be provided to Army Recruiting Battalion Commanders, as authorized in the survey, who will assist leaders in coordinating speaking and support opportunities in the agreed upon location(s).

Volunteer to become an Army Recruiter

The Army is seeking Soldiers from Specialist through Sergeant First Class who are interested in becoming recruiters.

The rewards for Recruiters are many. Soldiers who volunteer for recruiting duty have the option of selecting their priority of assignments under the assignment incentive program. They first attend the Army Recruiter Course at Fort Jackson, S.C. The 55-day course has five major segments: introduction to recruiting, management, eligibility, prospecting and sales techniques, and communication skills.

Following the Recruiter Course is a six-month non-rated new recruiter program, during which the new recruiters sharpen the skills they learned in the course.

If you volunteer and are selected to become an Army Recruiter, you will be joining a team of professionals dedicated to manning today's Army in the image of what the Army's leadership wants the Army to be. You will become an important member of the United States Army Recruiting Command (USAREC) family, and your job will require 110 percent of your energies.

Hometown Recruiter Assistance Program (HRAP)

The Hometown Recruiter Assistance Program (HRAP) allows enlisted Soldiers who have recently completed Advanced Individual Training (AIT), One Station Unit Training (OSUT) or Army Civilian Acquired Skills Training (ACASP) to return to their hometowns on permissive TDY for up to 14 days to assist the local recruiters by sharing their Army training experiences with family, friends, high school classmates, future Soldiers, veterans, and community leaders.

HRAP Soldiers report to the recruiting station and accompany recruiters throughout the community to assist in obtaining quality referrals for enlistment.

All permanent party Soldiers may apply for HRAP by submitting a DA Form 31, Request and Authority for Leave, through their chain of command.

Additionally, officers may also volunteer for HRAP duty in their hometowns or areas in which they are familiar, such as where they attended college.

Soldiers participating in HRAP may be eligible for the \$2,000 referral bonus if those referrals result in an enlistment.

Active Duty for Special Work (ADSW)

Army Reserve Soldiers of all ranks can support local recruiters to generate leads that will result in Army enlistments.

ADSW Soldiers may be eligible for the \$2,000 Referral Bonus if those referrals result in an enlistment.

Soldiers, USMA Cadets, ROTC Contracted Cadets, members of the Future Soldier Training Program, Army component retirees and Department of the Army Civilian employees can earn \$2,000 for referring their acquaintances to Army and Army Reserve recruiters, if those referrals result in enlistment.

The Referral Bonus Pilot Program, begun under a provision in the Fiscal Year 2006 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), was initially \$1,000. The bonus amount was raised to \$2,000 on Nov. 13, 2006. **(NOTE: Sponsors who provided referrals prior to Nov. 13, 2006, are only eligible for \$1,000 Referral Bonus)**

Soldiers, Future Soldiers, USMA Cadets, ROTC Contracted Cadets, Army component retirees and DA civilians may receive a Referral Bonus for referring anyone, except individuals that have served in the military previously and immediate family members. - Soldiers and Army component retirees who are serving as instructors, assistant instructors or contracted instructors in the Senior Reserve Officer Training Corps (SROTC) program or Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program
- Family members
- Individuals assigned to duties regarding which eligibility for a bonus could, as determined by the Secretary of the Army, be perceived as creating a conflict of interest
- Retired Department of the Army Civilians (unless they are also Army component retirees)

The \$2,000 Referral Bonus will be payable in two lump sums as follows for referrals submitted on or after Nov. 13, 2006:

\$1,000 will be paid to the eligible sponsor once the Soldier (referral) has commenced Basic Training. Payment requests will be sent to DFAS upon verification that the Soldier is in fact in Basic Training. Payment should be received within 45 days of request submission.

\$1,000 will be paid to the eligible sponsor once the Soldier (referral) has completed and graduated from One Station Unit Training (OSUT) or Advanced Individual Training (AIT). Payment requests will be sent to DFAS upon verification that the Soldier has completed and graduated from OSUT or AIT. Payment should be received within 45 days of submission.

To be eligible for the Referral Bonus, referrals must be made via the Army Referral System-Sergeant Major of the Army Recruiting Team (ARS-SMART) referral process. 
